What is the UVAMOBPLUS2 project?

The UVAMOBPLUS2 project is coordinated by the University of Valladolid, within the framework of the European Programme Erasmus+ Key Action 1 (KA171) "International Credit Mobility". This action is part of the International Dimension of the Erasmus+ Programme, managed by SEPIE in Spain.

It is a project of mobility of undergraduate, master and doctorate mobility, in addition to academic and administrative staff, between the University of Valladolid and the Partner universities from the 31 targeted countries outside the European Union. For the period 2022-2025 the project will implement at least 338 mobility exchanges in the different categories, both for incoming and outgoing: From Partner Countries to the University of Valladolid and from the University of Valladolid to a Institution in a partner country.

Our project Erasmus+ 2022-1-ES01-KA171-HED-000072505 for the period project 2022-2025 has been awarded with the 2nd biggest budget among the Spanish Higher Education Institutions, with 1.3 million EUR.



Who is eligible?

- > Student mobility in any study field and cycle (bachelor/master/doctoral)
- > Staff mobility by any type of higher education staff (both academic or administrative)

Types of mobility:

- > Student Mobility: SMS studies or SMP-internships
- > Staff Mobility: **STA/STT-teaching/training or STT-training**
